ON THE RECENT INFRACTIONS BY A MARYLAND CREMATORY

The Maryland Cemetery & Cremation Association (MDCCA) supports the investigation by Governor Wes Moore into the unacceptable conditions and violations by a Maryland crematory and the State's responsibilities and oversight of the Maryland death care industry.

"We condemn the alleged activity at this crematory and stand with grieving families and their right to honest and compassionate service providers," shared Nathan Nardi, an officer of the cemetery and crematory association.
